# Warm Spaces...

"...I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me."...'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me."

## Matt 25:35-36;40

Jesus made it clear that caring for those in need should be a priority for anyone in His kingdom. It's not an optional extra; it lies at the very heart of who our God is. In fact, Jesus says that any kindness shown to those in need is an act of kindness shown to Him!

The needs of families, couples and individuals in our community keep on growing. We have an opportunity to extend God's love to them. We're joining a community wide initiative to run warm spaces across Cam & Dursley. With a gap in provision on Sundays, it was the logical choice to keep the Community Hall open on Sunday afternoons; to provide a warm place for folks to grab a hot drink, meet friends, buy warm food and access support. The first session will be on November 6<sup>th</sup>.

The plan is that each Sunday will be 'adopted' by a team from one of our community groups. We need 3-4 volunteers for each week, so your community group leader will be asking you to sign up soon. We need our efforts to be sustainable for the long haul, so we want to avoid it becoming an onerous task!

As yet the plans aren't set in stone because this is a dynamic situation and we have to be prepared to adapt and alter our scheme in response to the needs that emerge.
