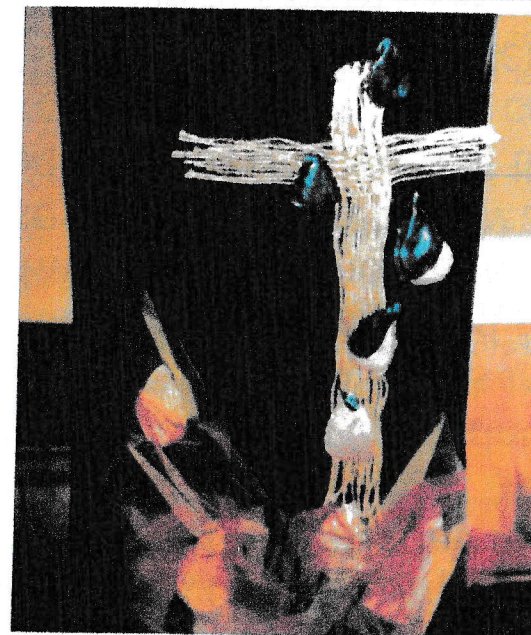

## PHILS THOUGHTS ON PENTECOST

### People, Place & Presence

The world has been changed by many great combinations - John, Paul, George & Ringo; Bacon, Lettuce & Tomato; Thrust, Lift, Drag & Weight...

But none of these will ever be as significant as what happened at Pentecost.

### **People**

Everyone was waiting. Jews waiting for the feast, Disciples waiting for the gift (*Acts 1:4*). All of them looking to God. We were created; created to worship. Jesus said that true worship is offered to the Father 'in spirit and truth' (*John 4:24*). It is in true worship that people find their purpose.

### **Place**

It's the Feast of Weeks, Jerusalem is crowded with 'Jews from every nation under heaven' (*Acts 2:5*) The whole world is gathered - what happens next will impact the entire global community! Pentecost gives us a glimpse of how our fractured world will ultimately be healed.

### **Presence**
