

Church Weekend Away – 8th to11th May

We are less than a month away from our first Church Weekend Away and there is a lot to be excited about! During our few days together we'll share fellowship, benefit from fresh ministry, enjoy great food, worship God and have loads of fun in beautiful surroundings.

Anthony & Ruth Taylor are joining us for the weekend to lead our gathered sessions. As a couple they have a passion to see people growing in their relationship with God. They have spent the last few years exploring simpler, less regimented, expressions of worship in their church; Grace Church, Thame. They will be sharing what God has laid on their hearts for us.

All the rooms for the weekend are now occupied, but it is still possible to book day passes - please speak to Phil Greenow if you'd like to join us for part of the weekend.

Roof Project Arrangements.

As announced at the AGM the Roof Project is scheduled to start very soon. So, how will this effect us with Church activities?

Phase 1 will be doing things to the main roof structure hidden up above the ceiling. We will be able to continue worshipping and all our current activities in the Chapel area without interruption. People coming to LifeLine and other activities will still be able to walk through the church to get to the hall. There will be signs of workmen's activities in the car park which might reduce parking a little. This phase will take about 3 weeks.

Phase 2 will be doing things to the church ceiling and there will be scaffolding inside the Chapel area. We will not be able to worship in the chapel on Sunday and will be meeting in the church hall at our usual time. We still will be able to access through the church from the car park disabled access into the hall on Sunday but there will be NO ACCESS through the main church doors from the road. We will NOT be able to use the church Chapel at all on weekdays BUT access for LifeLine disabled people will be permitted, by arrangement through Anna, to pass through the Chapel into the hall. We will be needing extra help to arrange seating etc before and after Sunday service. Depending how much space the contractors need for their materials we might have to restrict car parking to those who have walking difficulties and ask the rest of us to find roadside parking. This phase should last about 3 weeks and intended to flow straight on from Phase 1.

Phase 3. This will be work to repair/replace the roof itself and will require full scaffolding around the Chapel. We might not be able to use the Chapel for worship and, if so, we will be in the Hall on Sundays. It is hoped that this work will continue straight on from Phase 2 but that will depend on other factors, principally about raising finance. As this phase of the work is still to be confirmed in certain details more information will be forthcoming at a later date.
