## Roof Project Sunday Service arrangements

Subject to agreement with the Contractors as Peter explained in his last e-mail the work will recommence on September 1<sup>st</sup>.

Here is a reprise of the church worship arrangements that will take place during the Project.

The first phase will take about 3-4 weeks and will involve work above the ceiling to the structural timbers. We will be able to continue worshipping in the main body of the Church as usual and our usual current activities in the Hall will remain unchanged. There will be workmen activity in the car park which may restrict the amount of parking space available and priority will be given to those with disability issues. The second phase will follow straight on from phase 1 and again will be about 3-4 weeks during the month of October. There will be NO ACCESS from the roadside entrance during the Project. This work will chiefly involve doing things to the church ceiling and there will be scaffolding in a lot of the main chapel area.

The final (3<sup>rd</sup>) Phase is planned for November/December which will involve scaffolding around the outside of the church and we will still be worshipping in the hall because the roof will be open as tiles are removed and replaced. Allowing for weather to inevitably disrupt the best laid plans we must be prepared that this work may extend beyond Christmas.

You will appreciate that this is going to cause a lot of temporary disruption to our normal church activities. The hall will be full of chairs as well as accommodating the musicians equipment.

The Elders and the Admin Team are currently looking into these consequences in greater detail and will keep you informed as to how we are going to resolve these challenges before Phase II starts in October.
