

Latest update on Roof & Church Arrangements.

You will probably all have realised, by now, that the Roof Project has uncovered more items to be dealt with. The original approach to re-tiling the roof was to do it in small sections as the structural timber repairs progressed, however the Ecologist (Bats!) has insisted on being present each time tiles were lifted so it was clearly far more cost effective to take the roof tiles off all in one go. This, in turn, has meant the necessity for a 'Top Hat' covering to be brought forward and its associated scaffolding. This has not made any effect on our current budget but will effect it when the structural engineer investigates these extra problems which have now come to light. It has become quite apparent that we have been living on 'borrowed time' under the current structural condition of the church for some while and that events like a heavy snowfall could have had catastrophic results which, PTL, we have avoided. Anna provided us, in September, a more comprehensive report which was emailed out to you all.

Revised Church activity arrangements.

As we are going to be restricted to the Church Hall (Green Room) until, at least, early new year some of our regular activities like the Tear Fund soup lunches and Lifeline have been temporarily curtailed. Similarly our regular Sunday congregation reduction in numbers, according to the details spelt out last month, are now initiated.

Beryl has come up with a lovely 'Plan B' to maintain our support for Tear Fund by asking her cooking Team to produce a cake(s) for each Sunday post service coffee/tea and we are invited to contribute for each piece of cake we eat into the pot that Beryl will provide. She hopes to continue this, at least, up until Christmas.
